



Vineet Singal, Co-founder and Chief Executive Officer

Vineet Singal is the co-founder and CEO of CareMessage, a nonprofit, tech-first platform that helps safety-net clinics reach and support patients at scale. His work focuses on using technology to close gaps in access to care, clinical outcomes and social drivers of health. Vineet co-founded CareMessage in 2012 after navigating his own health challenges and volunteering in safety-net clinics as a pre-med student.



At national scale, CareMessage reaches more than 8 million patients across nearly 500 safety-net organizations in 45+ states and territories. Founded at Stanford in 2012, CareMessage has raised ~\$50M to advance health equity through technology via backers including Google.org, Salesforce.org, Twilio.org, PagerDuty.org, Ballmer Group, Johnson & Johnson, Y Combinator, Schmidt Futures, Direct Relief, the Michael & Susan Dell Foundation, the William K. Bowes Jr. Foundation, the Dovetail Impact Foundation, Sanofi, Echoing Green, and others.


Vineet's earlier work includes peer-reviewed research in cancer biology and epidemiology at Mount Sinai School of Medicine, the National Cancer Institute, and Stanford School of Medicine, and leading a nationwide Stanford Graduate School of Business initiative that registered more than 115,000 new bone marrow donors from underrepresented communities using social media. He graduated with University Distinction from Stanford, where he served as a student representative on the Board of Trustees and received the President's Call to Service Award. He is an Echoing Green Fellow, a Draper Richards Kaplan Foundation Fellow, a Y Combinator alumnus, and a winner of the Schwab Foundation Award for Social Entrepreneurship, the Hitachi Foundation Young Entrepreneurs Award, and Wharton's inaugural Beacon Award for Leadership.

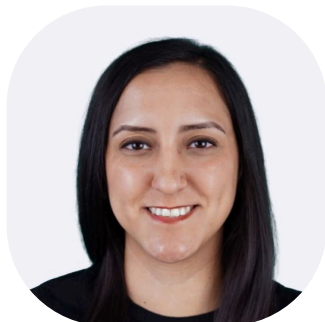

Cecilia Corral, Co-founder and Chief Strategy Officer

Cecilia Corral is the Co-Founder and Chief Strategy Officer at CareMessage, the leading patient engagement platform for safety-net organizations. Under her leadership, CareMessage has reached more than 22 million people across 45 states and territories.

Driven by her experiences growing up in a low-income immigrant household, Cecilia brings a unique perspective to the design of technology for health equity. Cecilia's work focuses on using technology and AI to scale preventive care and chronic disease management in underserved communities. Over the last decade she's been the lead inventor on multiple patents on the use of sequential messaging to support people in meeting health goals, and has been a contributor to key research validating the effectiveness of text messaging in improving health outcomes.

Outside of her work at CareMessage, she is an advocate for Diversity and Inclusion in the tech industry through collecting and publishing data on Latina Tech Founders. Cecilia was on the 2019 Forbes 30 under 30 list for Healthcare and was recognized as a Social Entrepreneur of the Year in 2025 by the Schwab Foundation for Social Entrepreneurship at the 2025 World Economic Forum. She holds a degree in Product Design Engineering from Stanford University.
